## Helping Your Church Understand the Need for Core Values

**CONCERNING LEADERSHIP** 

Core values are those enduring things that a congregation holds dearly and deeply, and are at the heart and core of the church's identity. These values strongly influence every decision made, action taken and dollar spent by the church. Core values remain fixed in a congregation while everything around them can be in a constant state of change. If they are removed, the people would feel as if it were not the same church.

Below is a list of some core values which have been divided into 6 sections. Place a "1" beside the TWO CORE VALUES you deem primary in each section. Place a "2" beside the one core value you consider secondary. *This is not an exhaustive list of core values and therefore you may wish to add others*. Remember, all of the items reflect common and/or Biblical values, but only a few are apt to be the driving values in your church's ministry.

An enthusiasm which is evidence that God is at work in our midst
Teamwork seen as an essential component to effectiveness of ministry
CONCERNING OUTREACH
Ministry that takes a special account of the poor and disenfranchised
Desire to have as many people as possible involved in foreign missions
Constant evaluation in an effort to make all aspects of the Church's ministry relevant to the culture it is attempting to reach (i.e. laboratory churches)
Reaching all people by all means for Jesus Christ
A church that speaks to the issues of social justice, civil rights, and equal right
Growth in numbers and maturity as indicators of effective ministry
A strong responsibility to community service on the part of the church
CONCERNING WORSHIP
Preaching and teaching developed on a Biblical foundation
Openness to creativity and innovation in worship with total lay involvement
Concerted effort to make visitors to the church feel we welcomed and eager to return to your church
Openness to a variety of worship styles where God's presence is felt
Communion and baptism given special attention as celebrations
Use of Contemporary worship music, multi-media, arts, drama
